II. LITERATURE REVIEW

Santisi. et. al, (2018) psychological resources, satisfaction, and career identity in the work transaction: an outlook to Sicilian college students did research was conducted by the team to identify whether the students are having academic

satisfaction and career identify and by preparing the questionnaire and shared with the group of 438 students and taken their review on the topic. Academic satisfaction had a direct effect on the confidence of the student and he would be able to perform extra good in their life.

A study was done by Singh. et. al, (2015) in Odisha among the colleges. The study found that the students choose a career according to their parents and later regret it. Instead of imposing their career choices on the students, the parent should consider the choices of the students and their interests and then decide what their child wants to do. If the student chose the career according to the parent's choice and on mutual consent, he somewhere has to go under the stress and also, he would not be happy with his career. So basically, the study claims the student should work on the career to which he relates himself the most.

Ahmed. et. al, (2017) researched business students as it states that there are many reasons why a student enrolls himself in business studies. There are many factors like the financial outcomes, interest in the subject and many other factors, the personality of the student, and many factors. The structured questionnaire was distributed among MBA/BBA students enrolled in different universities in Karachi. Data were collected from 120 participants and analyzed using SPSS.

Chethan Kumar, Times of India (2020), researched the suicide cases on students in the country. In his study, he states that in 2019 and the years, every hour one student commits suicide he also talks about the increasing number in cases and it comes around 27% increase every four years and this is a huge amount of country. While the proper career counseling is helping in stopping this.

IANS, India TV (2020) researched students considering their career change. In their research, they found that around 77% of students are considering their career change because this pandemic has changed the style of working. This is post covid and now students have to rethink their decisions about their decisions. Number of students happy with current career




Fig. 1 Number of students happy with current career

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


Fig 2. Was someone guiding you in choosing a career

If you would get the option, would you try something else




Fig 3. If you would get an option, would you try something else

Would you change your career in life, if a chance?




Fig 4. Would you change your career in life, if a chance?

If school helped the career would be different

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


Fig 5. If school helped the career would be different

Traditional career gets more respect in society




Fig 6. Traditional career gets more respect in society
