Where Age of Nursing Experts (in a years) shows no significance association withOpinion significance level p<0.005 (p=0.330). However, Gender had no significance associationwith Opinion at significance level p<0.005 (p=0.503),

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Education had no significance associationwith Opinion at significance level p<0.005 (p=0.649), Experience had no significance association with significance level Opinion at p<0.005 (p=0.176), Designation significance had association with opinion at significance level p<0.005 (p=0.022) and Source of Information had significanceassociationwith Opinion significancelevel p<0.005(p=0.01)

Hence it was concluded that Age of Nursing Experts (in a year), Gender, Education, Experienceshows no significant associationately elevely < 0.005 and Designation and Source of Information shows significant association at level p < 0.005.
